American cyclist Sarah Hammer set a new individual world record at the BTR Inc. designed AGUASCALIENTES VELODROME at the Pan American Cycling Championships this week. The record time of 3:22:269 was set during a qualifying round on 11 May 2010. The formally retired athlete, who returned to the sport in 2005, broke the previous record set by Kiwi Sarah Ulmer in 2004 by 2 seconds.

Located at 1,870 metres above sea level, the velodrome was only recently fully homologated by the UCI and was the setting for the 2010 Cycling Event which is the preamble and training grounds for the 2011 Pan American Games also taking place in Mexico (Guadalajara).

The Aguascalientes Velodrome is a 250 metre indoor facility that was built in 2009 by Mexican Construction Company DEPORTAN utilizing a custom BTR velodrome design with full design and construction supervision by Peter Junek founder of BTR Inc. /Junek Velodromes.
